
Ankomst: 02.07.2017 kl 21.45 med Norwegian til Gardermoen

1. Tag (27.06.): 11:35 am arrivol at Berlin-Schönefeld Airport. Continue to Wittenberg (115 km, ca. 1,5 h Walk to the Castle Church, where Luther posted his 95 theses at the "Thesentuer", to the Renaissance town hall, the Monuments of Luther and Melanchthon and the Luther House. Continue to Dessau and check-in at the Fürst Leopold Hotel Dessau (34 km, ca. 30 min). Individual dinner.



2. Tag (28.06.): 08:30 am day trip to Torgau (77 km, ca. 1 h). A walking tour takes you to the historic market, town hall and the patrician houses. Visit the Church of St. Mary to see Katharina Luther's tomb stone and the Nothelfer-Altar of Cranach the Elder, and Castle Chapel at Hartenfels Castle. Individual lunch break. Leisure time for individual visits. Return to hotel. Individual dinner.

3. Tag (29.06.): Continue to Erfurt (209 km, ca. 3 h), in the Middle Ages one of the largest cities in Central Europe. Martin Luther was the most famous student of the city; he studied in Erfurt between 1501 and 1505 and received a 'magister artium' degree from the faculty of philosophy. In a tour of the medieval center of the city see the architectural ensemble of Erfurt Cathedral and Severikirche church, one of the most impressive constructions of medieval architecture. Go on to Merchants' Bridge and the Augustinian monastery where Martin Luther lived from 1505 to 1511. Individual lunch break. Guided tour in the Augustinian Monastery. Leisure time. Continue to Friedrichroda and check-in at Ahorn Berghotel Friedrichroda (50 km, ca. 45 min) for 2 nights. Dinner at the hotel.



4. Tag (30.06.): Continue to **Eisenach** where Martin Luther attended the parish school of St. George until 1501 and held sermons before the Diet of Worms in 1521. Walk through the **old town** to the **Luther House** and **St. George's Church** where Luther was a choir boy and J. S. Bach was baptized. Visit of **Wartburg Castle** and the National Special(with audioguide), the former seat of the Thuringian landgraves where Luther translated the New Testament from Greek into German and St. Elizabeth stayed in the 13th century. Free time to stroll around the **castle plateau** and visit the **Luther Room**. Return to hotel. Dinner at the hotel.



5. Tag (01.07) Continue to Eisleben. A tour of the city includes a visit to Luther's Birth House, the market square, Luther Monument, the town hall, St. Andrew's Church and Luther's Death House. Individual lunch break. Continue to Leipzig (97 km, ca. 1,5 h). In a bus tour of the city see St. Alexei's Russian Memorial Church in Novgorod fashion, the Schiller House where the paet wrote the first verses of "Ode to Joy" in 1785, and Gohlis Palace — Leipzig's only palace building. Walking tour to St. Thomas' Church built in late Gothic style, the site where Martin Luther established the Refarmation in Leipzig and J. S. Bach worked as a cantor. To the Bose House, home of the merchant Bose and now housing the Bach Museum, "Zum Coffe Baum" Leipzig's oldest coffee house opened in 1694. Go on to Barthels Hof, the only remaining arcade of the time of trade fairs around 1523, to the old city hall at market square, to the old stock exchange of 1687, today a venue for musical performances and
