The Porvoo Communion of Churches Sharing a Common Life in Mission and Service

Work Plan 2012 to 2018

The Porvoo Declaration was signed at services in Trondheim (Norway), Tallinn (Estonia) and Westminster Abbey in the autumn of 1996. The Common Statement of these participating churches has been hailed at that time as 'the single most important ecumenical proposal' to be discussed by the participating churches in many years. The priorities for the coming years are listed as follows:
